Your participation and support of the 12th International Penguin Conference is a powerful demonstration of your commitment to protecting penguin populations and their ecosystems for generations to come.

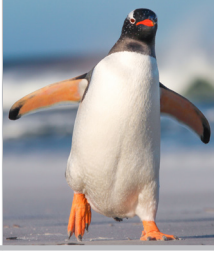
